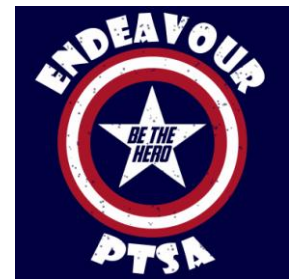

Safety Policy Statement from the Principal

As our long standing policy states, all visitors/volunteers must sign in at the office and wear a badge and sign out when you leave, and parents are not permitted to escort their child to the classroom. Endeavour has safety procedures and policies in place that have been vetted by our School Resource Officer and First Responder Liaison. Staff participate in regular drills and trainings. 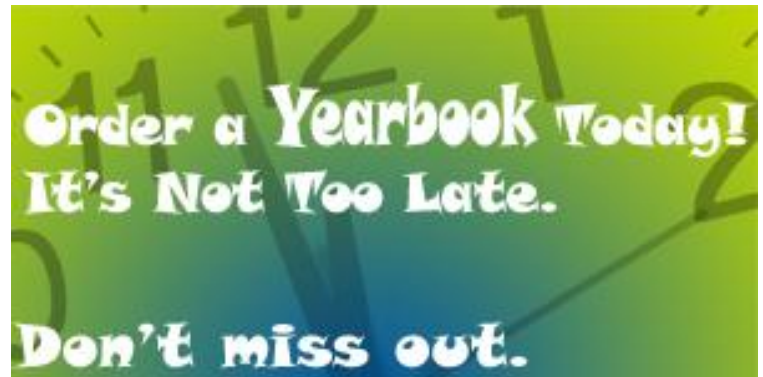
