#### Volunteer Partnerships

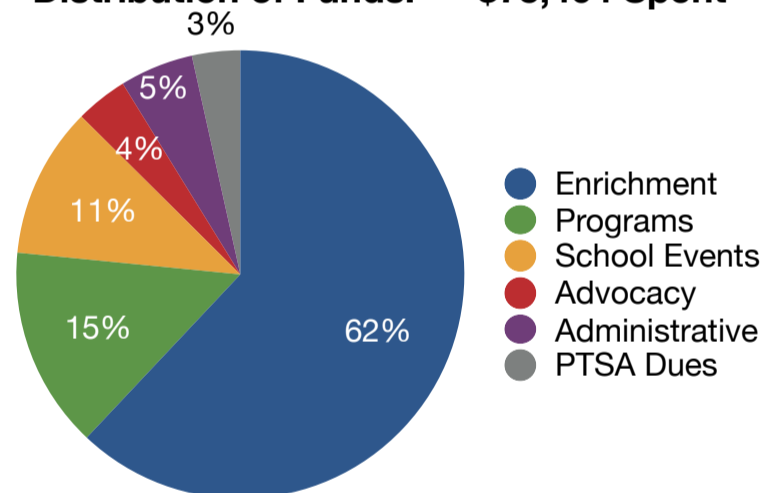
- Supported Endeavour by providing volunteers for picture days, vision and hearing screening, Kindergarten orientation
