## Reading A-Z

The Foundation has been focused on what we can do to most effectively support students during remote learning. To that end, we are excited to be able to supply these resources for all kids in the district. Reading A-Z offers a leveled digital library. It allows the teachers to get the “just right” books into the hands of students and work with them virtually as a class or in reading groups. They can upload to Seesaw and use the projectable screens to read for comprehension.



The Washington State PTA held their 42<sup>nd</sup> annual Legislative Assembly virtually over two days, October 23-24. Approximately 325 attendees joined together via Zoom to discuss, debate and vote on issues, resolutions and legislative priorities for 2020-2021. The assembly is a true democratic process, with members voting either pro or con for specific amendments attached to issues and resolutions and then voting to support their top five priorities.

With debate and voting concluded, here are the top five priorities and supported issues the state PTA will advocate and lobby in the upcoming legislative session.

### Top 5 Legislative Priorities for 2020-2021

- Increase Access to Nursing, Mental Health, and Social Emotional Learning Staff
- Support Students and Preserve Education Funding
- Increasing Educational Equity by Closing the Digital Divide
- Supports and Funding for Students with Disabilities and Their Families
- Prevent and Reduce Gun Violence and Suicide

### 2020-2021 WSPTA Supported Issues

- Equitable Identification and Services for Highly Capable Students
- Mitigating the Adverse Impacts of Climate Change
- Safe School Plans and Emergency Preparedness

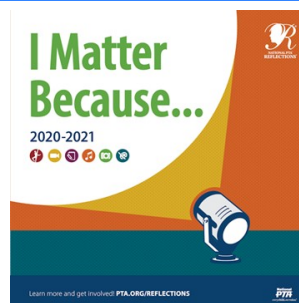
