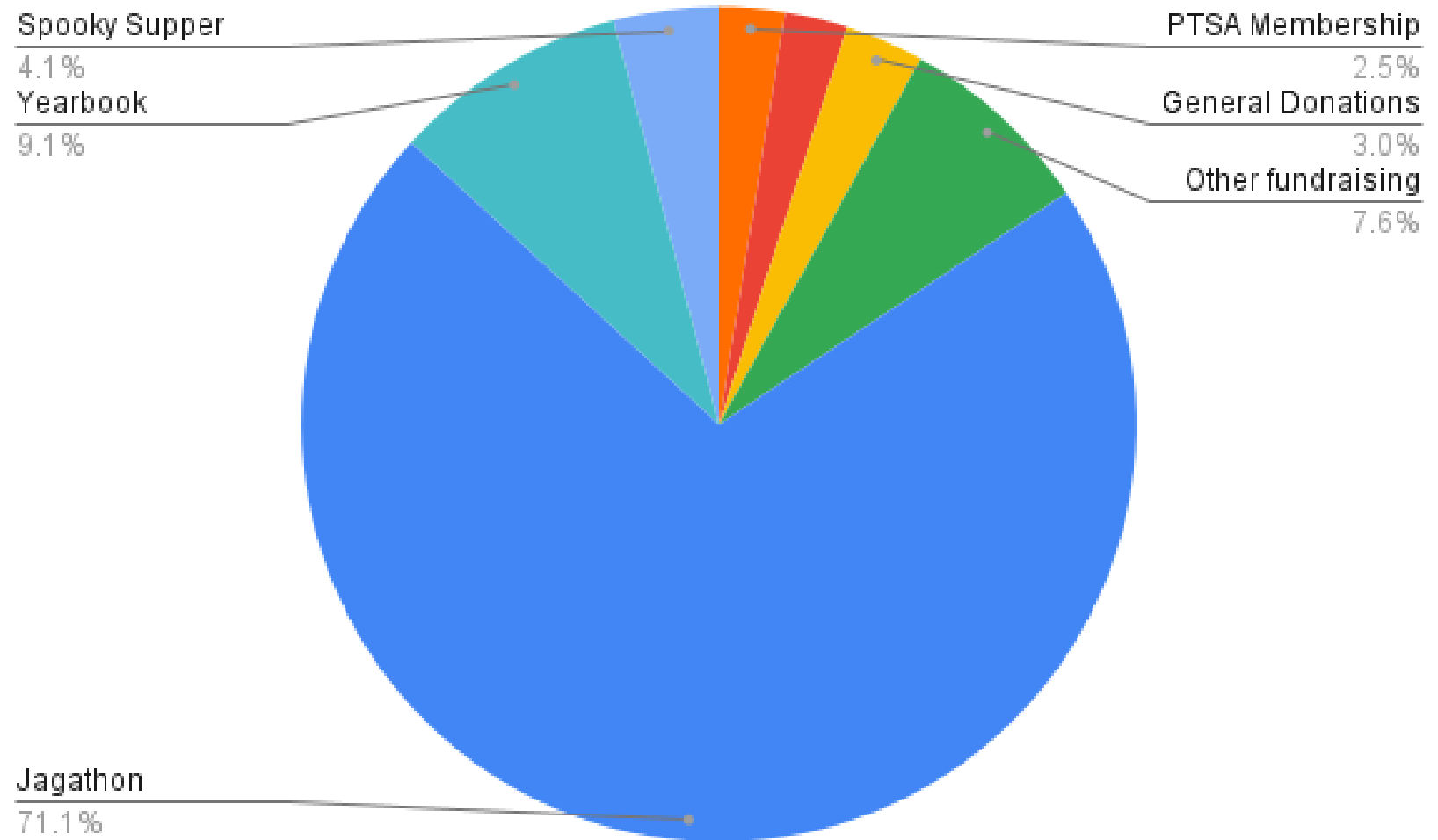
Financial Recap

2023- 24 Budget Adoption

- **2022-23**
 - Revenues = \$101,196
 - Expenditures = \$64,781
 - Net 'gain' of **\$36,414**
 - Strong fundraising last year combined with variance in Teacher/Specialists grant adoption
- **2023-24 Budget (Proposed – presented last May)**
 - Revenues = \$98,400
 - Expenditures = \$102,886
 - Will leverage cash reserves for variance of \$4,486
 - Financial cushion from last year, rising cost of events and volume of activities back up to "full"

2023-24 Budgeted Income

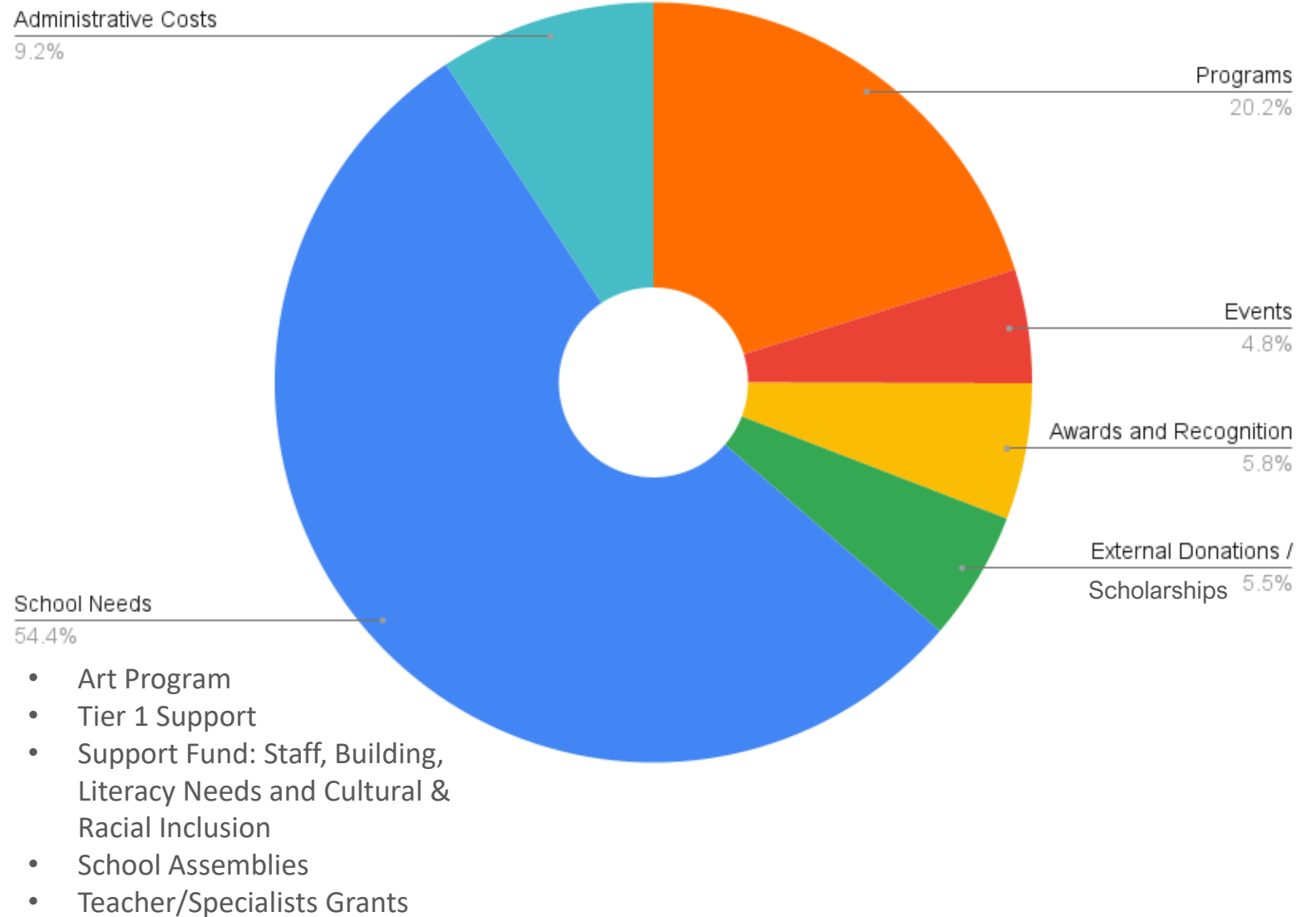

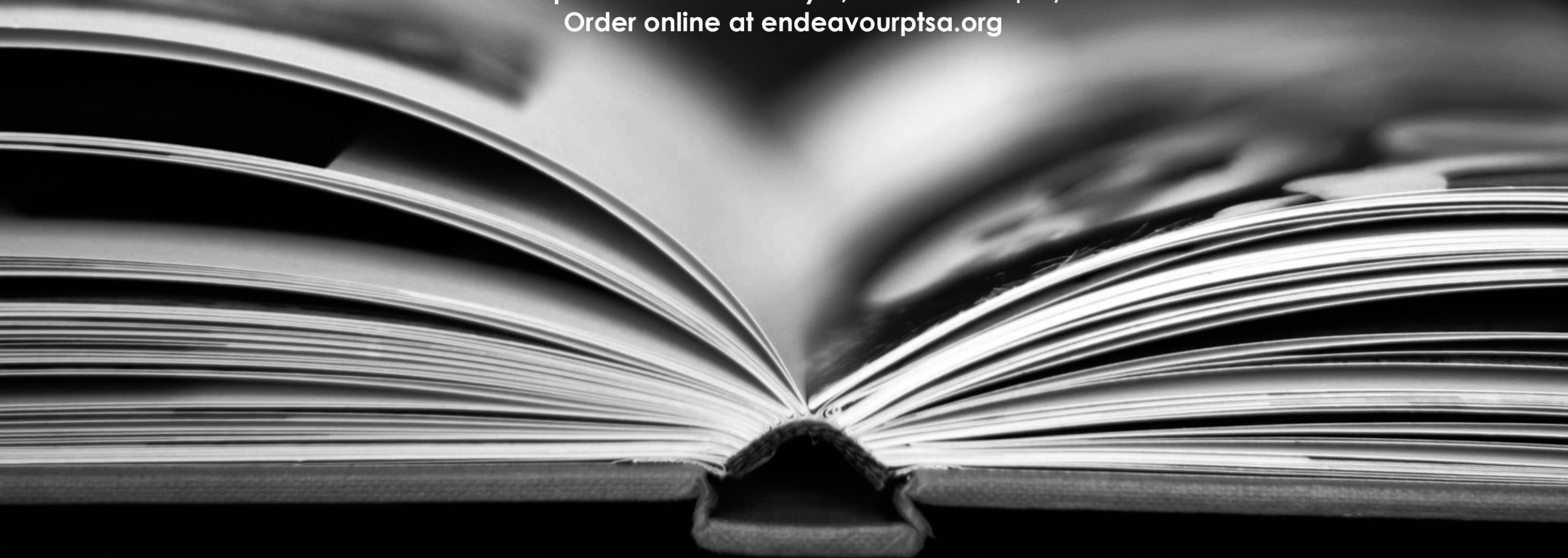
